

HOW TO DO STAGE MAKEUP



Base – Foundation applied generously and evenly over the face and neck to blend. The colour should be at least 1- 1½ shades darker than their skin tone.

Cheeks - Pink Blush to cheeks (get the child to smile then apply along the cheek bones)

Lips - Red lipstick for all female students.

Eyes - Brown/ Neutral eyeshadow from the base of the eyelids to the middle of the eyelid. Cream/ white eyeshadow from the middle of the eyelid to the eyebrows. (you may extend the eyeshadow out just past the eyes)

- Eyeliner running along both the top and bottom eyelid, with a “wing” extending out from the bottom corner of the eye towards the temple. This will ensure the eyes are more defined and open looking on stage.
- Mascara to the eyelashes
- For seniors who are able to and comfortable wearing them, false eyelashes may be applied.
- If your child has lighter/blonde eyebrows you can colour them in with a brown/black eyeliner to give them more definition.
